② Füssen on Lake Forggensee

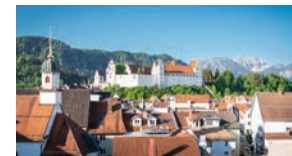

Sunny **1 Scheidegg** in the west of the Allgäu boasts picturesque views over Lake Constance and the Alps.

Nestling at the foot of Mount Zugspitze (2,962m), **2 Garmisch-Partenkirchen** is the epitome of dramatic and unspoilt Alpine scenery.

Then it's on to **3 Lake Spitzingsee**, rvia Schliersee, for wonderful walks around the mountain lake.

My travel experiences in ...

1 Scheidegg

A head for heights will come in handy at **skywalk allgäu**, a barrier-free treetop trail with views of the Alps; the **Kappellenweg trail** promises a treat for mind and body; and there's an opportunity to cool down in the idyllic Waldsee, Germany's highest **moorland swimming lake**, near Scheidegg

2 Garmisch-Partenkirchen

The AlpSpIX observation platform offers amazing views of the peaks around **Garmisch-Partenkirchen**; elsewhere; and there's the opportunity to tour the Olympic ski jump at a height of nearly 150 metres

3 Schliersee-Spitzingsee

Journey back in time to explore old mountain farms and customs at the **Markus Wasmeier open-air museum**; soak up the sun and the views over a piece of cake at **SLYRS coffee & lunchery**. Many a peak is waiting to be conquered around Mount Taubenstein and the Rotwand region, quaint mountain inns make for a cosy stop-off, and the **Spitzingsee cable car** provides a leisurely way to reach the top.

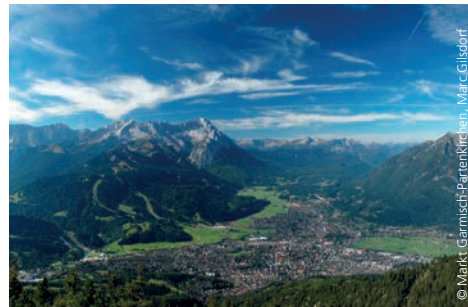

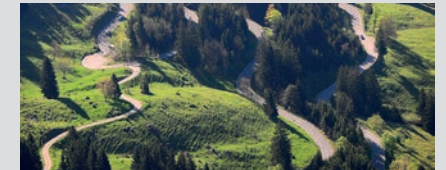

This road trip takes in the most popular Bavarian sights along the German Alpine Road in the Allgäu region and Upper Bavaria:

1 **Munich**, the capital of Bavaria and gateway to the German Alpine Road; 2 **Lindau**, the island and garden town in Lake Constance with a mediterranean feel; the world-famous Neuschwanstein Castle in 3 **Füssen**; and Mount Wallberg on 4 **Lake Tegernsee**. Arrival and departure via Munich.



Castles Neuschwanstein and Hohenschwangau

My travel experiences in ...

1 Munich – Lindau in Lake Constance 184 km / 114 miles

Visit to **Nymphenburg Palace** and walk around the park; guided tour of the **Olympic Park** and the former Olympic stadium; visit to **Hellabrunn Zoo** in Munich, the world's first 'geozoo', with over 500 animal species. The following morning, you continue by (hire) car to Lindau along the A96 road.

2 Lindau in Lake Constance – Füssen 112 km / 70 miles

The best way to see the spectacular entrance to Lindau harbour is on a **boat trip**; the **Flower Island of Mainau** in Lake Constance boasts an amazing variety of flowers; the **island town of Lindau** is well worth exploring whatever the time of day.

3 Füssen – Lake Tegernsee 184 km / 114 miles

Highlights include the famous castles of **Neuschwanstein** and **Hohenschwangau**; a guided tour of the **Museum of the Bavarian Kings** is highly recommended; the **Tegelbergbahn cable car** provides an easy way up to the summit, where you can enjoy panoramic views across the beautiful foothills of the Alps.

4 Tegernsee – Munich 60 km / 37 miles

In Tegernsee, the famous **herzogliches Bräustüberl** tavern is the perfect place to enjoy a relaxed Bavarian meal; it only takes 13 minutes in the **cable car** to reach to top station of Mount Wallberg, where amazing views over Lake Tegernsee await; and on a **pleasure cruise** you can get closer to the shimmering waters of the lake.



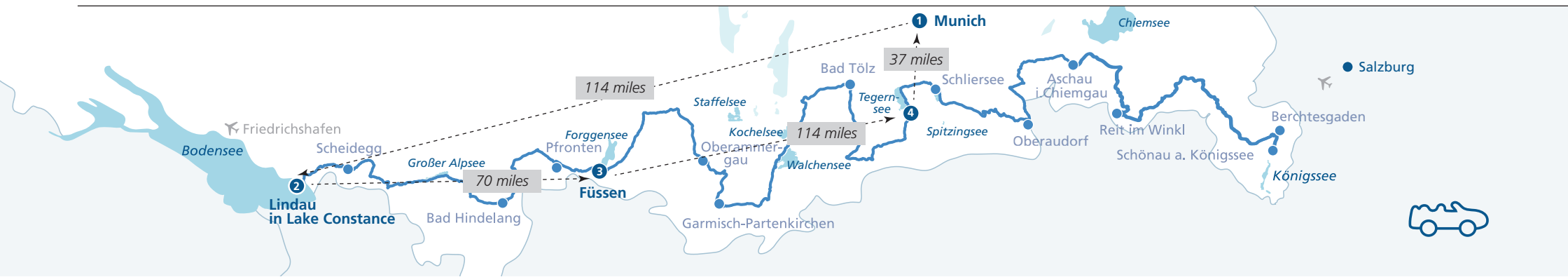

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Short-trip through authentic Bavaria along the east of the German Alpine Road

7 days / 6 nights
545 km / 338 miles



This short trip takes in the most popular Bavarian sights along the German Alpine Road:

1 **Munich**, the capital of Bavaria and gateway to the German Alpine Road, the Kehlsteinhaus (Eagle's Nest) in Berchtesgaden, the Winklmoosalm plateau in 2 **Reit im Winkl** and Mount Zugspitze in 3 **Garmisch-Partenkirchen**. Arrival and departure via Munich.



Eagle's Nest

My travel experiences in ...

1 Munich – Berchtesgaden 154 km / 96 miles – Reit im Winkl 62 km / 38 miles

Listen to the famous town hall carillon on a stroll across Munich's **Marienplatz square**; the **Hofbräuhaus beer hall** on Platzl square is the perfect place for a hearty Bavarian meal; in the afternoon, you can watch surfers riding the waves on the Eisbach river in the **English Garden**. The following morning, continue by (hire) care along the A8 to Berchtesgaden, where we recommend taking the Kehlstein bus to **Kehlsteinhaus**, or Eagle's Nest.

2 Reit im Winkl – Garmisch-Partenkirchen 239 km / 148 miles

The Winklmoosalm plateau is the most famous part of **Reit im Winkl**. During the summer, you can reach this popular walking area with its quaint huts and welcoming Bavarian inns via a toll road or by cable car; explore Lake Chiemsee and Herreninsel island by boat, and visit **Herrenchiemsee** Palace, built for King Ludwig II in the style of Versailles. The next morning, continue along the German Alpine Road towards Garmisch-Partenkirchen.

3 Garmisch-Partenkirchen – Munich 90 km / 56 miles

Explore the historical sights of **Garmisch-Partenkirchen**, and experience nature at its best on the winding, 700-metre trail through Partnach Gorge with its steep rock faces rising up from gushing, green-hued waters; take the rack-railway or cable car up Germany's highest mountain, the almost 3,000-metre **Mount Zugspitze**, see the golden cross on its summit and take in the extensive views across Garmisch all the way to Munich.

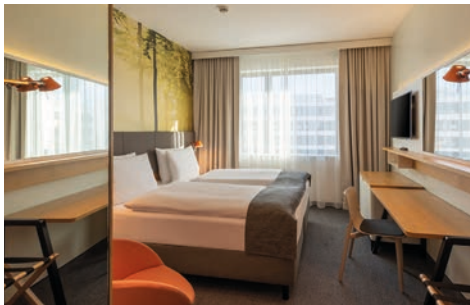

3 Füssen – Munich 120 km / 75 miles

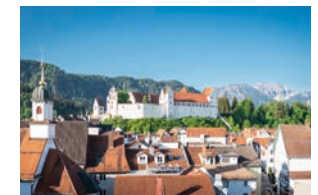
